Place and Venue

The Nordic Bridge Team Championship will be played in Icelandair Hotel in Keflavík, 5-10 minutes drive from Keflavík Airport.

We will pick up all teams at the Airport and transfer to the hotel.

Registration and Entries

- All NBOs has to enter their team's participation for the champoionship latest of February 28th 2013 to Ólöf <u>bridge@bridge.is</u>
- Each NBOs has to enter the names of their players and other officials month later, March 28th 2013 to Ólöf bridge@bridge.is including photo of each participant.
- All convention cards has to be sent in PDF files in the end of April 28th to Ólöf <u>bridge@bridge.is</u>
- Each country has to pay 99.000 ISK per participant covering full board and accommodation in single room for 4 nights, from Thursday 23th May afternoon to Mondy 27th morning.
 For double room, the fee will be 93.000 ISK per participant.
 Extra nights are charged for single room 18.000 ISK and for double room 21.000 ISK including breakfast

Dresscode

The NBU supports a dress code at its Championships. NBOs are required to provide their players with appropriate uniforms carrying a badge or emblem identifying the country represented during play. In addition everyone entering the playing rooms is obliged to wear the official name badge provided by the organization.

We start playing on Friday 23th May at 10:00

The schedule will be readdy depending on the number of participating teams.

Prize giving ceremony and farwell Lunch/Dinner will be at 16:00 on Sunday 26th

Format

The Championship will be played in two series – for woman and open teams.

The two series are for National teams only, both players must come from the same NBO, transnational players are not permitted in the teams. Team can be formed of maximum six players, captain and coach Both series will be played with pre-duplicated deals and screens One match from each series will be on BBO each round. Double round will be played with 16 boards without half time.

Home team make their line upp after the visiting team has made theirs.
